

HELPFUL TIPS FOR USING CHAT IN ZOOM

1. While in a meeting, click **Chat** in the meeting controls (To get to meeting controls, move your mouse over the screen to Chat is the callout cartoon button) 
2. This will open the chat on the right.
3. You can click on the drop down next to select using the down arrow "Everyone" or a "specific person" in the meeting.
4. You can then type a message into the chat box. Press ENTER to send the message.
5. The chat box on everyone's screen will then have a number in it to indicate that someone is "chatting" with everyone OR only the chat box on the specific person's screen will indicate a message to him or her.
